Bids on estimated 2010 requirements for:

RECYCLED / MODIFIED GRAVEL

will be received by the Elmira Water Board at its office at 261 West Water Street, Elmira, New York until 10:00 A.M. on Wednesday, December 09, 2009. At this time the bids will be publicly opened and read.

The amounts below are estimates only and the quantities actually ordered will be as needed to meet demands during 2010.

Bids must be in sealed envelopes and the quoted material designated on the outside of the envelope. Standard Non-Collusive Bidding Certificate, Waiver of Immunity and Certification of Bidder regarding Equal Employment Opportunity must be signed and submitted with the bid.

The Board has the right to reject any or all bids and to re-advertise for new bids at its discretion.

Amount - Approximately 1,500 tons

Specifications - The Granular Fill shall meet the following specifications :

1. The specifications are the same as those provided by the State of New York, Department of Public Works, Division of Construction in their manual entitled " Public Works Specifications" of January 2, 1962, second printing, page 299, Item 2EF-B, Selected Granular Fill.
2. All material for this item shall be of such size as will pass a 3" square sieve. These particles retained on the 1/4" square sieve shall have a loss, after four cycles of the Magnesium Sulfate Soundness Test, not exceeding 30% by weight.
3. Vendors may bid using their standard price sheets if applicable.

Delivery - Selected Granular Fill is to be delivered to the Elmira Water Board Maintenance Shop Yard at 760 Bonview Street, Elmira, New York. Bidders price must be per ton with weigh slip from certified scale delivered to the Elmira Water Board Maintenance Shop Yard.
